NAVI-MIG project was created as a contribution to inclusion and integration of recently arrived migrants. The successful integration and inclusion of migrants in Europe is critical for our collective well-being, socially and economically. Migrants are at a greater risk of social exclusion than the native population, especially when it comes to accessing health and social services, education, proper housing, and employment. Successful migration integration starts with enabling newly arrived migrants to access essential services and help them get settled and oriented in their new residence. In this project, we are developing a mobile application that offers information and access to essential services like health care, education, housing initiatives, job centres, social services, child support, etc.

The third TPM for NAVI-MIG project was held in Belgium on 28-29 March 2023. All partner organisations had already met in Helsinki for the 2nd TPM and discussed the progress of PR1 and its finalisation. In this meeting the partners analysed the progress of PR2 and mainly; the outline of the mentoring programme, how they are going to organize the active mentoring sessions and which tools are going to be used. All they exchanged their experiences and their thoughts, and they are looking forward to starting with a call of participants. The mentoring program is supposed to last for a year, in which the mentors will help migrants in specific areas chosen by them in order to enhance their knowledge and skills for the market place.

Also, the finalisation of PR3 was discussed as well as stakeholders' feedback. Project management and dissemination were analysed in detail, as well as any other issues the partners brought up. The cooperation between the consortium is at the highest level which ensures the effective implementation of the project.
